

JUDGE RINDER SENSITIVE INFORMATION PRIVACY NOTICE

Introduction

This Judge Rinder Sensitive Information Privacy Notice supplements our Privacy Notice for Programme Applicants, Participants and Contributors (which can be found at <u>www.itvstudios.com/privacy-notice/talent-contributors-audience</u>). This Judge Rinder Sensitive Information Privacy Notice is not intended to override that notice; both notices should be read together.

Any reference to "you", "your" in this Judge Rinder Sensitive Information Privacy Notice is to you. Any reference to "we", "us" and "our" is to ITV Studios Limited (company no. 03106525) and its subsidiary companies. Unless otherwise stated below, we are the "**data controller**" of your personal data and you can contact us at <u>privacy@itv.com</u> or write to the ITV Privacy Team at 2 Waterhouse Square, 140 Holborn, London, EC1N 2AE for more information about how we process your data.

What do we mean by "Sensitive Information"?

During the application and selection process for, and recording of, "Judge Rinder" (the "**Programme**"), we may collect and use information about you at various stages in the production, some of which may be sensitive in nature concerning your health and your criminal history. We refer to this information about your health and your criminal history collectively in this document as, "**Sensitive Information**".

Where do we get this Sensitive Information?

This Sensitive Information is most likely to come from you (for example, from telephone interviews with you during the application process) but it may also come from third parties (for example, from people connected with you so that we can verify the information you have given to us, or from our insurer, or from medical professionals working with us). Where authorised by UK/European laws, we may also carry out our own background checks, which may include internet and social media searches.

What Sensitive Information do we collect and why?

Type of Sensitive Information	Why do we collect this Sensitive Information?
Health	To assess your suitability to participate in the Programme.
	To meet our duty of care and health and safety obligations to you and other people taking part in and/or working on the Programme.
Criminal convictions, current or pending criminal proceedings, county court judgments, and/or formal cautions	Due to the high profile nature of the Programme and the potential scrutiny contestants may come under.
	To assess your suitability to participate in the Programme.
	To meet our duty of care and health and safety obligations to you and other people taking part in and/or working on the Programme, and our duty of care to our viewers.

There may be circumstances where we use your Sensitive Information (or make your Sensitive Information available to third parties) without your consent, for example:

(1) where you clearly make your Sensitive Information public, for example, by agreeing that it may be included in the Programme and not withdrawing such agreement before the Programme is broadcast;

- (2) in the event of a medical emergency;
- (3) in relation to a legal claim and/or court order;
- (4) where it is used lawfully in the substantial public interest; and/or
- (5) where it is necessary for the 'special purposes' of journalism art and literature.

Otherwise we will only use your Sensitive Information for the above purposes (or such other purposes as have been confirmed to you in writing) with your explicit consent.

Who uses this Sensitive Information and with whom do we share this Sensitive Information?

This Sensitive Information will be used by the employees and staff who are working on the Programme on a need-to know basis. It may be shared internally with our Business Affairs, Health and Safety, Compliance and Insurance teams. Where necessary, it may also be shared externally with our professional advisers, the commissioning broadcaster, our insurer, the insurer of the commissioning broadcaster and medical professionals working with us, such as our on-site medical team, our independent doctor and our independent psychiatrist. If the Sensitive Information is included in the editorial content of the Programme with your consent, it will be shared with anyone who views the Programme and/or clips of the Programme throughout the world.

Any third parties with whom we share your Sensitive Information will be required to comply with current data protection and privacy laws.

In the case of our insurer, and/or medical professionals working with us, they will be a "data controller" of your personal data and will be required to maintain their own records. Where that is the case, we may refer you to those professionals to exercise your rights over your data.

How long do we keep this Sensitive Information?

If you appear in the Programme.	The period during which we have the right to exploit the Programme.
If you take part in the Programme but do not appear in the finished Programme.	 Health data – where necessary, up to 3 years from the last date of your contribution save that if an injury has been notified to us, we may keep the data until the claim or claims have been resolved. All other data - Up to 1 month following the last transmission of the final episode of the Programme.

Sending Sensitive Information internationally

We may transfer your Sensitive Information to other members of our group and to third party service providers outside of the European Economic Area, which do not have similarly strict data protection and privacy laws.
